The Chartered Financial Analyst® (CFA) credential is the among the most respected and recognized investment management designations in the world. Requirements to earn the CFA credential include:

- Holding a bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from an accredited institution.
- Successful completion of all three exam levels of the CFA Program. Roughly one in five candidates complete the CFA Program, averaging approximately 4 years to pass all three exams.
- Completion of 48 months of acceptable professional work experience in the investment decision-making process.
- Abiding by and adhering to the CFA Institute Code of Ethics and Standards of Professional Conduct.
